### Casting

Project 1 is about On-Site casting (Ensamble Studio path 1). Each student team is expected to produce a family of casts that addresses specific ways (texture, light, space, etc) of turning Matter into Form. The collection of casts should reflect a focused and intentional set of material experiments.

# **Imaging**

Project 1 is about making images from On-Site casts. The images and casts are two distinct methods of construction. The images are not representations of the models. Each team is expected to construct a compelling set of images that expand the material "reality" of the casts.
